



An information by the waste management company/kooperative of Pfaffenhofen/Ilm - february 2016

The green can is meant to dispose of all clean waste paper in the household. See backside for examples. Reprocessing the paper collected contributes to reducing waste and protecting our environment.

Here some tips on how to proceed correctly:

- The paper can is emptied every four weeks
- The date of collection is found in the collection schedule published annually, or on our homepage.
- At the day of collection, please place the can at the side of the street by six o'clock a.m.
- Put only clean and dry waste paper into the can to enable sensible recycling
- If the can is too small for the amount of your waste paper, further containers can be made available for a fee; an application is required

Cardboard (packaging) can be dropped at Wertstoffhöfe in every community of the county except Pfaffenhofen city, Weihererstrasse 16. Please put only disassembled cardboard pressed flat into the collection containers.

A container for **printed material** like magazines, newspapers, catalogues, books etc. is available at Wertstoffhof Pfaffenhofen county, Martin-Binder Ring 4.

The paper Can is



- newspapers
- magazines
- catalogues
- books (without leather or plastic covers)
- envelopes
- printer papers
- clean cardboard packaging (non-laminated)
- packaging for detergents or eggs
- paper bags for sugar or flour
- any other clean waste paper



- papers resistant to wetness
 e.g. waxed or laminated paper for
 wrapping cheese or butter
 paper cups or milk and juice containers
 ⇒ yellow bag
- paper soiled by paint, oil or glue
- wallpaper
- cement bags
- used papers for hygienic purposes e.g. tissues, diapers, household tissues, sanitary towels etc.
- fatty and wet paper
- other waste
